- Long-term mission preservation beyond any one generation

- **Legal Status**: Contractual association existing under First and Fourteenth Amendment rights.

- The Commonwealth Council (up to 13 members) will serve as a deliberative body across all three entities.
- **Council Roles** include Chief Steward (Brodysseus), Executive Advisors, Elders, Trustees, and Elected Patrons.
- All major decisions will require **consensus or supermajority vote**, depending on the scope.
- All land and core assets are held in perpetual trust, immune to sale, lien, or outside capture.
- **Ecclesiastical arbitration panels** will be available to resolve internal disputes in good faith.

Succession plans ensure that in the event of founder incapacity or death, the mission and community governance continue in right order.
